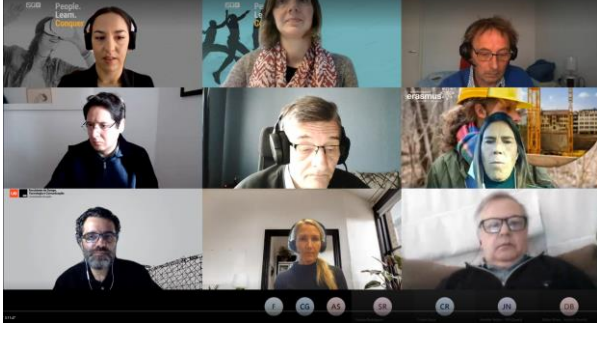
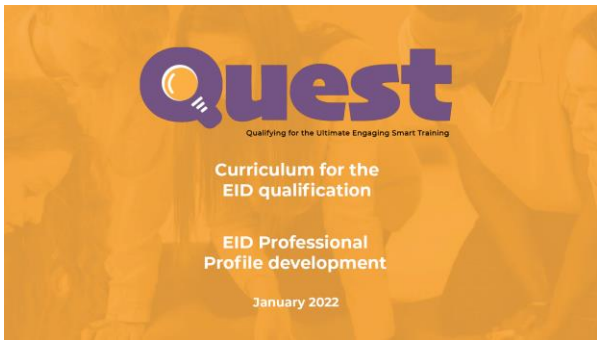




## News

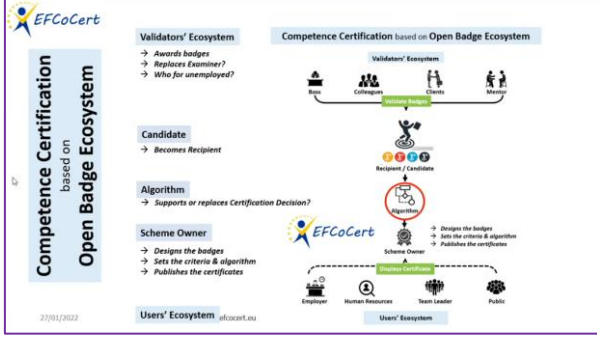


The QUEST Kick-off meeting took place online on January 28<sup>th</sup>, with 17 participants from the partners organisations - ISQe (PT), IADE (PT), University of Turku (FI), Future in Perspective (IE), EFCoCert Foundation (CH), EDEN DLE (EE) and with participation of the Portuguese Erasmus+ National Agency.



Project result 1 is the Curriculum for the **European Instructional Designer** qualification, which is being led by IADE, who present the development of the Professional Profile.

All partners engaged in a deep discussion about the scope of the profile and the role of eLearning in it's competences.



EFCoCert led the discussion about the creation of a Competence Certification system, showing partners innovative possibilities to implement recognition of learning (previous acquired or during the course).

Partners are studying the possibility of adopting an Open Badge Ecosystem in the scope of the Project Result - Recognition of Prior Learning process.

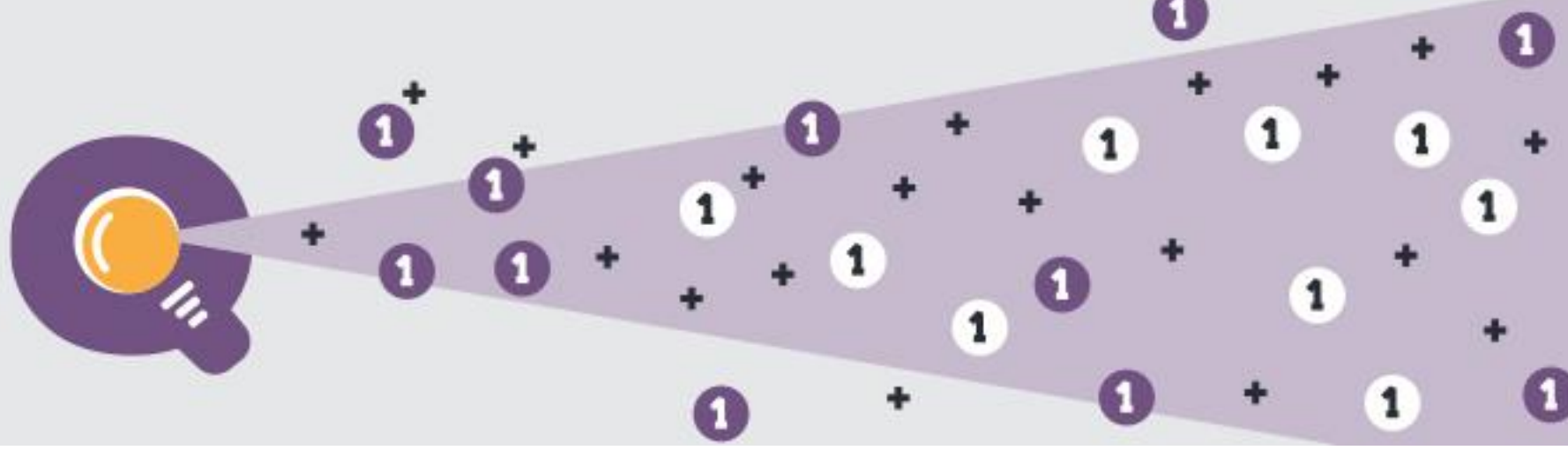

## About the project

COVID19 imposed emergent remote teaching and learning at a global scale. This mass and unprecedented use of technology for learning led teachers, trainers, learners and families facing a steep learning curve, thus exposing the weaknesses in need of improvement in order to successfully integrate digital technologies into education and training systems. QUEST partners identified the need for the new European Instructional Design' Professional Profile. Instructional designers are the 'architects' of the learning experience and the 'directors' of the Instructional Systems Design ISD process (Instructional Design Central).
